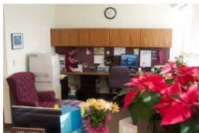

PROGRAM: Renovation of a 17,000 square foot vacant building into a new technology center including a new mission critical data room and various support staff and technical operations. The project included 75 staff to be relocated into the facility.

COST: \$800,000 +/-

DESCRIPTION: This project involved renovating an existing building for four distinct employee services related to the BOCES information technology department. These included; Administration, Technical Support, Audio/Visual and Programming departments. Also included was the design of a 1,500 square foot mission critical data room that serves as the main data center for all of Monroe BOCES No.1. The space needed to be altered to meet current building code requirements and included new ADA compliant toilet rooms and staff rooms. The design also included offices and conference areas as well as a large open floor plan for modular partitioning.
