

Bell Corporation Maintenance Facility

PROGRAM: 10,000 SF free standing pre-engineered steel framed metal truck maintenance facility.

COST: \$550,000

It is a 10,000 square foot pre-engineered building that serves as a truck maintenance facility for Bell Corporation. It also includes front office area that has access to the main building's maintenance area. A pre-engineered structure was selected due to the type of facility and the associated cost.
