

Miller's Millworks Addition & Fire Restoration

29 South Lake Avenue, Bergen, New York

PROGRAM: 7,450 Square Foot 2-story addition to an existing woodworking fabrication shop..

COST: \$270,000

This was a fast track fire restoration project to an existing millwork fabrication shop in Bergen, New York. Fire destroyed the original late 1800's timber frame building. We designed a new 2-story replacement structure for the Owner while clean-up of the site occurred. Working with the local building officials and Owner we provided a fast track project to allow Miller's Millworks the opportunity to be operational as soon as possible. The exterior was designed to tie in with the local architecture and farming community, while acknowledging the connection to the adjacent railroad tracks on the south side of the property. It utilizes subtle design cues and wood frame construction to connect the building to its heritage and community while being sensitive to the overall cost of the project..
